Craft: "Beatitude Garden"

You will need (craft supplies)

- Paper or notecards
- Scissors
- Paper bags or baskets
- Markers or decorating materials
- Glue or tape
- Popsicle sticks

Procedure : How To Craft Directions

- 1. Cut the paper into geometric shapes or flower shapes.
- 2. Decorate the paper with the words of the beatitudes, adding a picture for reminder reference. If space allows, write the starting line on one side of the paper, and the conclusion on the other side.
- 3. Glue or tape the papers onto popsicle sticks.
- 4. Decorate a basket, bucket, or bag to hold the beatitudes; or merely cut slits into a large sheet of construction paper.
- 5. Place the "flowers" into the container. Use as a reminder of the words of Jesus!
